Wilderness First Aid & Leave No Trace

Wilderness First Aid is a course that teaches participants how to provide life saving care in a back country emergency situation. Leave No Trace is an outdoor ethics program that teaches ways to reduce impact on the environment. Minimum Age 16



DNR Hunter Safety

Learn safe handling of firearms in an outdoor setting and obtain certification in Hunter Safety. Then practice your marksman skill at EBSR's shooting ranges. Minimum Age 12.



American Red Cross: First Responder

This is an intense, professional level course. Class time is over 40 hours and certification is good for three years. Minimum Age 16.



Basic Leader Training

Basic Leader Training is a three day course that introduces essential training for all Scoutmasters, assistants and new leaders. Minimum Age 18.



BSA Aquatics Supervisor

Work on the requirements to complete the BSA Aquatics Supervisor certification. You must meet all prerequisites on the first day. Certification is good for three years. Minimum Age 16.



Climb on Safely and Climbing Emphasis

Scouts and Scouters are invited to attend the Climb on Safely and Climbing Emphasis Program. Get certified in Climb on Safely and test your skill at the EBSR climbing tower. Challenge your body and mind. Push

yourself to the limits and conquer the rock! Minimum Age 14



DNR Boater Safety

Learn boat safety and proper boat handling on the Castle Rock Flowage. Minimum Age 12.



BP Boot Camp

Are your skills up to par? Want a crash course in all things scouting? Then BP Boot Camp is for you. Learn all the outdoor skills you need to be a leader, teacher and guide to the youth of scouting. Designed for youth leaders and new adults, spend your time learning the patrol method and crucial scout skills to pass on to your troop in a hands on, outdoor setting. Minimum Age 14.
