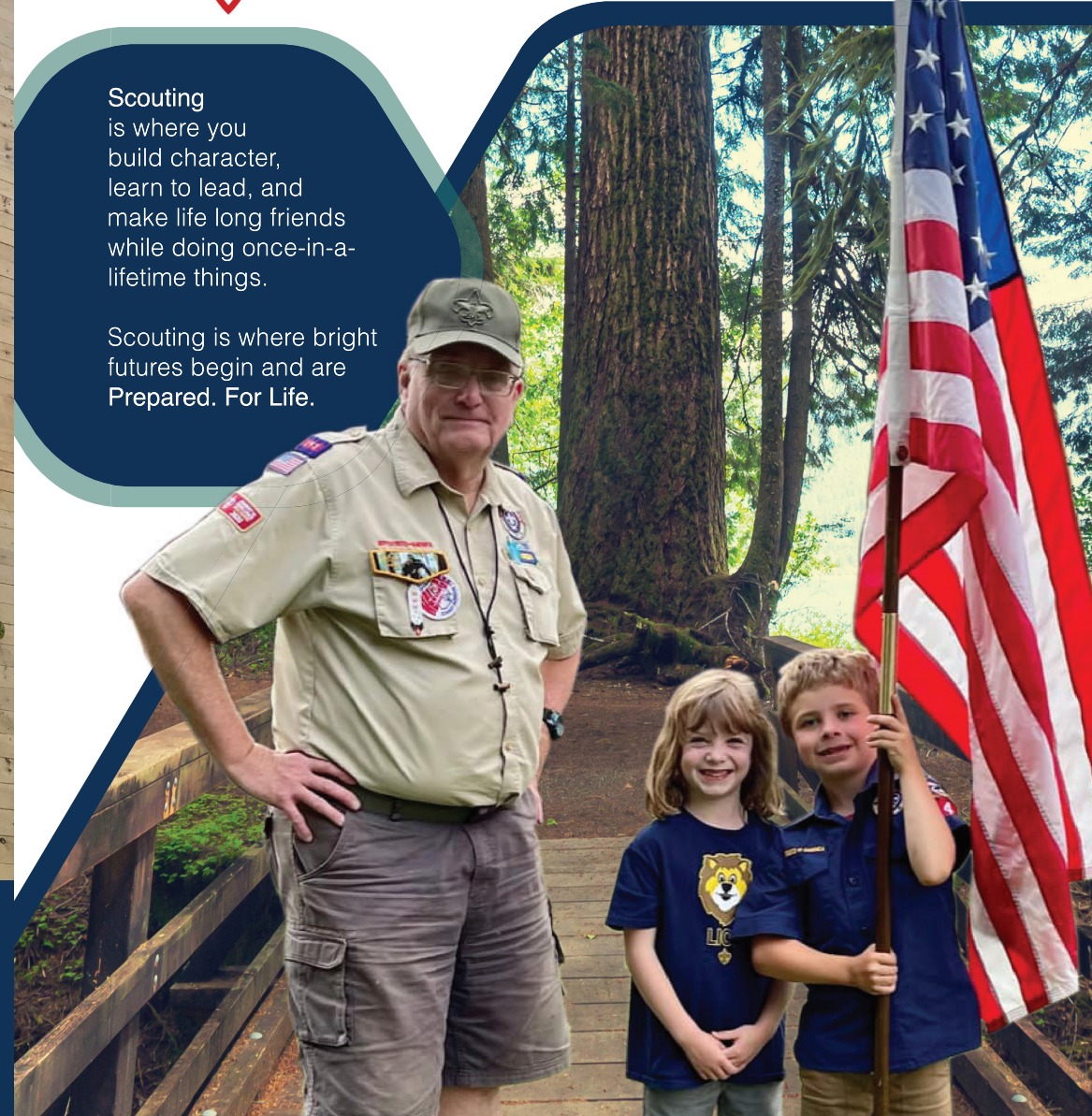

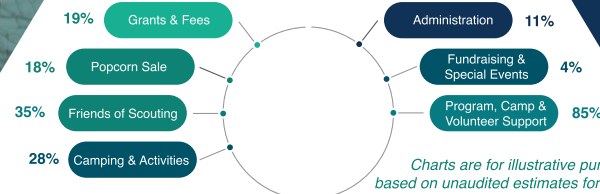
Pounds of Food Collected for Local Food Pantries
