

# Ed Bryant Scout Reservation

## Campmaster Program



The Campmaster Corps serve as the council/camp representatives, providing commissioner type support, and guidance to the Scout units and groups using EBSR for the weekend. Members will have a working knowledge of the BSA Outdoor Programs and the Guide to Safe Scouting.

Campmasters can also provide relief to the Camp Rangers from unit responsibilities for the weekend, freeing them for other work, as well as personal time off.

### Requirements

1. Must be a trained and registered Scouter with the Glacier's Edge Council.
2. Must be at least 21 years old.
3. Complete Hazardous Weather Training. Ideally, have experience in outdoor camping skills and knowledgeable about BSA program and Safe Scouting practices.
4. First-Aid & CPR training is desired.
5. Be willing to serve as a Campmaster a minimum of one or two weekends per year at EBSR.
6. Be familiar with Ed Bryant Scout Reservation camp.
7. Have good communication skills.

### Job Duties

1. Always remain on camp property to be available to assist units with problems or emergencies.
2. Interact with the Unit Leaders to provide Commissioner-type service and other assistance as needed.
3. May work on camp service projects.
4. Check units into camp upon arrival Friday evening.
5. Inspect facilities and check units out prior to their departure.
6. Provide unit leaders with outdoor program and facility assistance – Location of firewood, water, and latrines.

### General Information

- Camp equipment is available for use if you work on camp projects or need to deliver materials to the units.
- Some camp equipment may require training and protective gear prior to use.
- Campmasters may stay in an available lodge, typically OML or CRL.
- Weekend duties are Friday evening through Sunday Morning.
